## Maths focus:- Measure using a ruler, cm , m and mm

## How many of these activities can you complete this week?

## Task 1:-

Measure using a ruler.
Use a ruler (or tape measure), estimate the length of 5 items under $10 \mathrm{~cm}, 5$ items between 10 and 20 cm , 5 items between $20-30 \mathrm{~cm}$ and 5 items over 30 cm . Record your estimates, then measure them accurately to the nearest mm with the ruler.
