Well done to Kestrel class who shared a wonderful class assembly it was lovely to see what they had been learning. Next Term we will be inviting children's adults to come and share in their assemblies. These are not extensive productions but help to build confidence in presenting short pieces of information to larger groups of people.

We have a very exciting week coming up with lots going on. We have the athlete Rich Parker coming into school to support our fund raising event with Sports4School which will provide sports equipment for the school and help to sponsor professional athletes to continue to compete at a professional level. All children will need to come in PE kits in the morning, then we will then complete our sponsored circuits and have a special demonstration assembly from Nick.

We are continuing to take collections for the Foodbank and Easter Eggs for the raffle please bring these into the office.

This week, Robins have finished their work on The Way Back Home by Oliver Jeffers by doing lots of talking around the story. We received a postcard telling us all about the Martian. He asked us some questions about friends and what we like doing with friends. Robins have been planting cress and sunflower seeds as part of their work on growing and were excited to find that some of the cress has germinated already. Thinking about coming into springtime they have been learning the names of baby animals and matching them to their mothers. Well done!

In Woodpeckers we have been doing some end of term quizzes and all of the children have aimed high, been respectful of others doing their quizzes and had a go at all questions. They have been superstars! They are all still really enjoying learning about trains in history, animals in science and using the bee bots in computing.

Fantastic learning by all this week in Owl class. They have cooked cheese straws in DT, practising the skills of following a recipe as well as cutting the straws. In Geography, they have looked at different human features that are in Devon compared to Île-de-France, ask the children if they can remember any human features. They have also tested the strength of different magnets in science to see which magnet could hold more paperclips.

Kestrels explored the force of gravity in science this week. Ask them how they aimed to use a force greater than gravity to stop a ping-pong ball from falling! In English, they completed their page for our class book about animals. They are very proud of their page and the book is a wonderful mix of animals and intriguing facts!

This week in Eagle's class all of the children have been completing teacher assessments under test conditions in order to prepare for SATS. The children have been outstanding and we have been really proud of their resilience. Well done, Eagle's class!
