Dear Parents/Carers,

I wrote again last week to the parents of Owl Class to update them on Mrs Wright's absence. We have now heard from her that she will be on sick leave until at least 4 January 2016. I have therefore sought and gained agreement from Governors and CAST (our Multi Academy Trust) to make a temporary appointment of a teacher to teach Owl class until the end of July. This will be for 3 days a week alongside Mrs Perks who will continue to teach for 2 days a week. Many thanks to Mrs Perks who has done a great job to stabilise the class and work alongside Mr Durant, our supply teacher.

As last year, Mrs Burrough has been working with the choir on our entry for the BBC Devon Star for Christmas competition. We were very excited to hear that we have reached the final again and the BBC came into school to make a recording of the children on Monday. They also interviewed me!

The 8 finalists' carols are being played on the radio, one each day between Sunday 22 and 29 November. Ours was played this morning at 8.30.
