Not only have they listened to and story mapped the story, they have also watched an orchestra and listened to their performance of Prokofiev's Peter and the Wolf. They were enthralled by the musicians and their musical performance.

Woodpecker Class have started learning their new book where they have been finding out about the life of Amelia Earhart. They have really enjoyed learning facts about her life. They have also started their Advent topic in RE. They thought really hard about ways that they can be kind in December and they created a kindness advent calendar as a class.

In Owl class, the children have completed their independent writing of chronological reports. Photos of their amazing work will be shared on the website. In computing, they have created some fantastic drawings using paintz.app. They have also enjoyed learning about fossils in their science learning.

Kestrels have begun to think about Advent in both RE and Music.
Kestrels learnt about the meaning of the Advent wreath and what the candles represent. In music they are learning songs for their Advent service including 'Light the Advent Candle."

This week Eagle class have been learning all about the author Charles Dickens as part of a unit on biography. In Science they have used their knowledge of evolution and adaptation to investigate and ask the question: Does the shape of a bird's beak have an effect on the food that a bird can eat? We discovered that certain beak shapes are better suited to certain foods.
