The cost is £140 for each child

We are unable to give any automatic discounts for siblings.

Financial help may be available to anyone having difficulty in paying full fees. This can be arranged through your Parish Priest.

As places are limited and to avoid disappointment, you may wish to secure a place for your child with a non-refundable deposit of £40 immediately.

The remaining balance of £100 must then be received by 30th June.

<u>Application forms</u> should be returned to <u>Susanne Kowal</u> as soon as possible, together with the appropriate fee and a stamped addressed envelope. Cheques for the payment may be post-dated up to the 30^{th} June 2017, if this will avoid financial difficulty. (See application form for details.)

Applications will close on 11^{th} July 2017. Please note that applications may close early if all places have been filled.

Places will be allocated from the 1st May 2017

Transport to and from Camp

Parents are expected to make their own arrangements for getting to and from Camp. Directions will be sent nearer the date.
